Extended Care Hours

- Extended Care is an additional fee per week per camper.
- Camper must be signed up for regular camp to participate / register for extended care.

Drop Off and Pick Up Locations

- Drop Off: is outside in the parking area nearest the soccer arena. A table will be set up with staff to assist with sign in.
- Campers must be dropped off by 9 am and must attend the first day of camp each week to hold their spot.
- Campers may be picked up at any time, once picked up campers may not return that day.
- Pick Up: if picking up before 4 pm, the sign out binders will be located at the front desk of the YMCA. A front desk staff member will assist you in checking your ID and sign out. Staff will radio the counselor and inform them the camper is going home. Staff will provide authorized pick up a slip to hand over to the counselor when picking up. This slip will tell the


- Navigators- geared for our oldest campers, ages 11 up. Ages subject to change depending on registrations.

TRADITIONAL CAMP OVERVIEW: Traditional Camp consists of Art Projects, Literacy, Physical Fitness games and activities and afternoon swim time at the Y location only. Each week campers will be welcomed with a new theme.

Campers will rotate between art, literacy, physical fitness, snack and lunch. It is important for each camper to have a backpack to keep their personal things together. We encourage each camper to come with a backpack, jacket, re-usable water bottle, lunch with snacks, sunscreen and closed toed shoes.
