



Dear Valued Patient,

We wanted to inform you that Marian Regional Medical Center in partnership with the Santa Barbara County Public Health Department will be administering COVID-19 vaccination to Santa Barbara County residents 75 and older during a four day clinic, **by appointment only**.

- When: **Thursday, January 21 -Sunday, January 24**
- What time: **By appointment ONLY, 7am-5pm - Call 805-739-3815 or click [here](#).**
- Where: **The vaccination tents will be set up directly across the street from Marian Regional Medical Center's front entrance (1400 E. Church Street, Santa Maria) at the Employee Parking Lot on the corner of South Palisade Drive and East Cypress way (See map)**

Health care workers who provide care in Santa Barbara County will also be eligible to take advantage of this opportunity to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

At the time of vaccination, residents age 75 and older will be asked to provide proof of age (drivers' license, state ID, passport, or birth certificate) and county residency (drivers' license, state ID, mail with name and Santa Barbara County address). Health care workers will be asked to show their name badge from their employer located in Santa Barbara County.

We ask everyone coming for the vaccine to please go straight to the tents and not enter the hospital. We also ask that anyone who is experiencing any illness on the day of their appointment to please not come for the vaccine.
